What to expect when arranging a funeral

We're here to help you understand how much a funeral costs. We'll explain everything from our funeral director costs, to the cost of the service. We'll make it clear, to help you make a choice on which funeral will be right for you.

It's your choice on how grand or simple you'd like the funeral to be, from the type of coffin or transportation you choose, the date and time of the service will also determine how much a funeral costs.

Breakdown of funeral costs

The cost of a funeral is made up from:

- the funeral directors services
- third party costs, doctors' fees, burial or cremation fees
- added extras, flowers, limousines and notices in the paper



What's included in our standard funeral packages

Attended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Legal arrangements Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£740.00
Collection of deceased person Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	£200.00
Chapel of rest Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises.	£200.00
Coffin Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from veneered oak.	£295.00
Viewing of the deceased Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with funeral directors (where viewing is requested by the customer).	£25.00
Hearse At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£395.00

What's included in our standard funeral packages

Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial - £1,349

(Funeral Director's charge only)

Cremation - £1,500

(Funeral Director's charges plus the cremation fee*)

Fees you must pay

Burial - National average cost

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee.

This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

In this area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:

For a new grave, you will also pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge for a number of other fees.

Cremation - National average cost

For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee.

In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors fee as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

Cremation - Tyne and Wear

In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:

Hearse and limousine Additional mileage (price per mile)	£1.00
Transfers Additional transfers of the deceased person's body, to their home, place of worship etc. (price per transfer)	£200.00 - £295.00
Ashes Collection and delivery of ashes	£30.00
Embalming Delaying the natural effects of death	£150.00
Officiant Funeral officiant – Celebrant, Minister of Religion etc.	£220.00
Additional Services supplied outside of normal office hours	POA
